Payment of Fees:

- 1 Once a student has been registered as attending at the start of an academic year, Tuition and Maintenance fees for the full year apply. Where a student withdraws or suspends study from a course during the year, the full fees for the year are still due.
- 2 Tuition and Maintenance fees can be paid in full at the start of the academic year and a discount of 1.0% will be given if fees are paid by 20 October (the discount does not apply to Student Loan or Placement Partner payments). Alternatively, payment of those fees can be spread over 3 equal instalments, to be paid by 20 October, 20 January and 30 April, unless otherwise agreed.
- 3 Unpaid fees are liable to incur a late payment penalty of £10 per week until the balance is cleared. Failure to keep up with the schedule of payments normally results in termination of studies.
- 4 Fees shown are applicable only for the current academic year and are likely to rise in future years.

Notes:

- a This fee covers the use of College facilities, accommodation and meals during three block study weeks at Moorlands Christchurch campus. For students at MSW, this is normally paid directly by the student's supporting Placement Partner.
- b Registration is a one off charge that applies to all students. It must be paid prior to the start of the course, and is not refundable.
- c The discounted registration charge will apply for all students registering before 31 May, or those registering within two weeks of the offer of a place.

Additional Moorlands Midlands charges:

There are four block weeks held locally at Moorlands Midlands in Year 1, reducing to three block weeks in Years 2 and 3. The costs of lunch and teas/coffees during these block weeks are covered in the tuition fees above. You should arrange and pay for your own accommodation and other meals during those weeks, as needed. As an indication, the additional cost of accommodation and all meals at International Mission Centre in Birmingham was around £52 per night (2015/16 prices, subject to change).

Additional Moorlands South West charges:

For students who are linked in to the South West Youth Ministries network and whose placements are set up through SWYM, the additional local costs of the course are met by the student's supporting Placement Partner and will be £1,950 per year in 16/17. As indicated in note a, the Maintenance Fees are also normally paid by the Placement Partner.
